

Subjunctive and Optative

Morphology pp.155-57, 161-64.

Subjunctive: long vowels, -η, -ω

Optative: adds -ι- to vowel; secondary endings, -μι in 1S; legacy endings in Aor. Act.:

Subjunctive in Dependent clauses:

- ἵνα, ὡς, ὅπως Purpose (that, in order that, or 'to') p.172
- cl. of fearing fears for the future p.197
- conditions Protasis of present general, future more vivid pp.172-73
- conditional relative whenever (ὅταν, ἐπειδάν), whoever (ὅστις ἂν) p.204
- Temporal ἔως, μέχρι until we may... – uncertain future p.204

Optative in Dependent clauses:

- Secondary sequence In place of indicative and subjunctive w/ past tense gov. vb. p.181
- conditions Past general, future less vivid p.181
